

How to take part in the call for Bachelor Degrees and One-Tier Degree Courses

To participate in the call, the candidate must submit two applications to choose the degree program and participate in the Tolc test.

The first application must be completed on [Esse3 Unical](#). Users who access the platform for the first time must first sign in. Once obtained the credentials, the candidates can fill out the application for admission, selecting the degree program: at this point, applicants have to select “menu” and, immediately after, “secretariat” and “calls for applications”. From here, the candidate can submit the application for admission, indicating only one degree course (the candidate can change the choice until **31 May 2023**).

The second application will allow the candidate to book the Tolc test. It must be completed on the portal [cisiaonline.it](#). Cisia requires a payment of 30 euros for registration to each Tolc candidates are interested in. To make the reservation and the payment, Cisia generally provides a deadline of **about 7 days before the date of the test**, but it is appropriate to check the official deadlines on the website of the Consortium.

The Tolc test can be repeated, but not more than once a month. The ranking, in this case, will take into account the best score obtained.

The dates scheduled by the University of Calabria to take the TOLC test are: 29, 30, 31 March 2023; 26, 27, 28 April 2023; 24, 25, 26 May 2023.

The provisional rankings will be published by 8 June, the final ones by 14 June.

After the publication of the final rankings, the registration phase will begin.
